SECTION I - PURPOSE

The purpose of this Annex is to task USM-1 with certain responsibilities relative to the processing of [redacted] material.

SECTION III - TASKS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. USM-1 will page-print such semi-processed [redacted] perforated tapes as may be supplied on a continuing basis by the Director, NSA.
2. USM-1 will scan and page-print any accumulations of unprocessed [redacted] perforated tapes.
3. Detailed technical instructions for the performance of these tasks will be as contained in Tape Scanning Procedure Guide, copies of which will be forwarded USM-1 by technical channels.


