- b. (1) The Board recommends that Mr. Friedman be instructed to submit specifications to the Patent Section for the necessary action with a view to obtaining letters patent under the provision of Section 4886 of the Royled Statutes.
- (2) The Board recommends that the invention be not considered important in the Mational Defence, and that a non-exclusive license to the Government, in writing, be required.
