Patent Application on Facsimile Encipherment

1 Mr. Hall, In accordance with our telephone Patents Sec.conversation a few days ago, I am Legal Div., sending you herewith a copy of the OCSigO. sketches, description and correspondence relative to certain systems for enciphering facsimile which were conceived and forwarded to the Patent Section a number of years ago. I hope that it is not too late to file one either of both of these systems and, in view of the fact that processing was not started soon after the recommended action of the Patents Board, I would like to suggest that these cases be given some priority if possible. I am particularly interested in the one dated January 24, 1936 because I believe it would be much more practicable than the other in connection with present facsimile systems.
