

The present status of Greek and Turkish adherence to NATO is as follows: At the NATO meeting in Ottawa which took place in October 1951, the Council of Foreign Ministers agreed to present to their respective Parliaments a protocol for the adherence of these two states to NATO. So far, only the British Parliament has ratified this protocol which must be ratified by all the Parliaments before an invitation can be sent to Greece and Turkey. Once this invitation has been sent out by the US Government, the Greek and Turkish Governments must ratify it, thereby completing the act of accession.
