1. FLATCHER CASE

Mr. Starlin indicated that the final draft of the minutes of the hearing of the Fletcher case had gone forward and saked whether there were any corrections. Mr. Starlin explained that upon the request of Mr. Lawson, Mr. Fletcher had been granted permission to submit some further evicence in his case and, though Mr. Starlin had spoken to Mr. Fletcher about the matter several times, the raterial had not yet been obtained. It was decided that a letter should be written to Mr. Fletcher setting a deadline date as 3 lebruary for the submission of the additional material and if it had not been received at the end of that time the case would be decided on the basis of present evidence. Mr. Starlin indicated that he will draft a letter to this effect immediately. Discussion followed concerning the action which would be taken in the event that charges are upheld and Mr. Fletcher chooses to appeal an adverse decision to higher authority. Mr. Sterlin advised that only in case of an appeal to higher authority in the mar Department will the frency have to withhold finel action.

2. WAGE SCALE

Employment Found is designated as Panking Committee with the responsibility delegated by the Corranding Officer for keeping ungraded jobs in alignment. Fr. Starlin presented to the Board a new Proofreader Job in Security Division which is to be entered into the proper place on the ladder diagram of grades and steps of jobs. He adviced that the decision of the Cormittee will go forward to higher authority in the "er Department for approval. After a lengthy discussion of the duties and responsibilities of the position in question, Poard members agreed that the job had a great deal in common with already established CAF-4 positions and that the Proofreader Job should be a grade which most closely approximates the CAF-4 selery level.
