M/R: On 27 Dec 60, the Director, NSA, advised that he does not desire to be responsible for the security of COMINT procurements awarded for activities other than MSA. Further, that SEC take action to transfer security responsibility for Project 466L to the Air Force. A meeting was held with representatives of AFCIN on 6 Jan 61 to attempt to program a schedule of transition. This was impossible because it was not known what Gen Walsh's reaction would be or how the Air Force would continue the program. The AFCIN officials requested that MSA prepare a letter to officially notify the Air Force of the pending transfer of responsibility. This letter was written to fulfill the Air Force request.
