MEMORANDUM FOR THE MEMBERS OF USCIB:

Subject: Final Papers of [redacted]  
COMINT Arrangements For SACLANC.

Reference: USCIB 14/260 dtd 1 December 1952.

1. Vote sheet replies to the reference indicate the approval of all members, with the following exceptions:

- a. Director, NSA: Commented upon possible inadvertent contradiction in paragraphs 11 and 12 of the Annexure to the Basic Principles Governing COMINT Arrangements with Third Parties within Allied Commands, and recommended that these paragraphs be reworded.
- b. Navy member and Army member: Each recommended that the indicated portions of paragraphs 11 and 12 (referred to in a., above) be reworded as follows:

"11. International cooperation in Y within SACLANC's Command is expected to consist of:

- a. Coordinated shore-based direction finder operations by national nets and stations organized and controlled as mutually agreed among the participating nations.
- b. (No change)
- c. (No change)
- d. (No change)

"COMINT UNITS IN THE SACLANC AREA NOT ENGAGED IN SUPPORT OF FORCES UNDER SACLANC"

"12. Each nation with forces serving under SACLANC may individually arrange to operate in SACLANC's area national COMINT units not provided specifically or exclusively for support of the forces under SACLANC. These units will not operate as
