


Following telephoned to  (in the absence of Brig. Tiltman):

1. USCIB met yesterday afternoon in a Special Session and reviewed the report of the Ad Hoc Committee studying the matter. It accepted the Report with a few changes, which will be incorporated in the report and 10 copies of the document will be ready to be handed over this afternoon, I hope.

2. This paper is not to be regarded as a position paper because we have not as yet reached a firm position on the problems involved and indeed USCIB wishes to extend the agenda to include a review of all the conclusions reached at the 1951 conference on this subject. LSIB is being notified of this officially right away.

3. We hope to reach a firm position after discussion with their team and hence we propose to use their paper and our paper as bases for discussion at the conference.
