The following points might be added:

1. Emphasize the shortsightedness of building special machines for special jobs. It is much more costly in the long run, like buying cheap shoes is more costly than buying a good pair. Look at the O-3 - iron a drug on the market to the tune of over a million dollars.
2. The way Eastman works, all 3 machines if contrasted for simultaneously would probably cost no more than any two of them if contrasted for separately.
3. In the post war period RAM will be a godsend because ^{comparatively} only a few people will be needed to operate it. ~~and~~ ^{IBM} machines and personnel will be absolutely and completely OUT.
4. As these machines are being built new changes will develop which will make them ~~of~~ ^{of} more + more universal in application.
